- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills (written, verbal, listening and presentation).
- Knowledge of post-secondary technology and trades programs.
- Planning, organization, coordination and follow up skills.
- Client service oriented and able to work in a collegial environment.
- Proficient in computer applications including MS Office, email, Internet research and database management.
- Extensive marketing experience.
- Self-motivated and results oriented.
- Knowledge of provincial, federal, and international employment and labor policies an asset.
- A valid driver's license and the use of a dependable vehicle is preferred.
